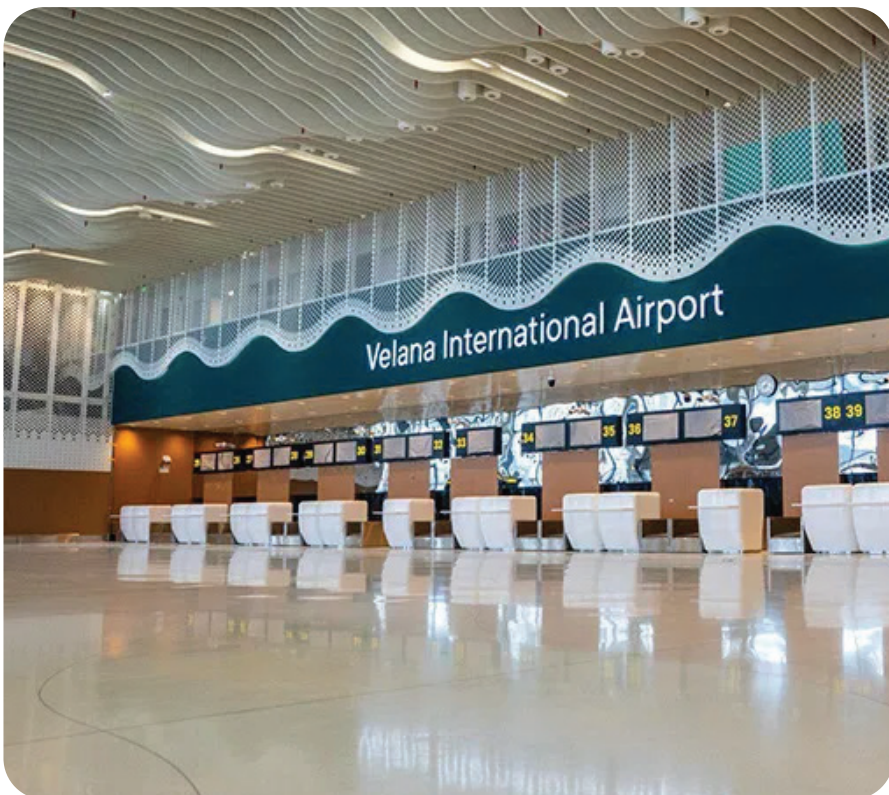


VISA INFORMATION

The Maldives offers a 30-day free tourist visa to all foreign visitors.

For a smoother entry, please ensure to have the following available:

- A valid passport with at least six months' validity.
- Proof of confirmed accommodation during your stay.
- A return ticket or onward travel itinerary. IMUGA Travel Declaration.

MEETING VISA

Maldives 14-Day Meeting Visa (On Arrival)

Key Requirements

- The visa is for a short stay of up to 14 days.
- It is issued on arrival for attending meetings, conferences & conventions in the Maldives.

Eligibility Conditions

The main purpose of travel must be official participation in a meeting, conference, or convention related to:

- Business activities
- Government functions
- Approved/authorized events

Documents & Requirements

- A confirmed return ticket.
- A prepaid hotel booking in a registered accommodation.
- Invitation Letter from the Conference Secretariat.
- Proof of sufficient funds to cover the stay in the Maldives.
- Submission of the IMUGA Travel Declaration within 96 hours before flight departure. <https://maldives.earrivalform.com/apply>.
- A valid passport or travel document with Machine Readable Zone (MRZ).
- Passport must have at least 1 month of validity remaining.

Important Passport Rule

- Passports with manually extended validity are NOT accepted.
- Only passports with officially printed validity dates are allowed.

Additional Entry Conditions

- Travelers must also meet the entry requirements of their onward destination (if applicable), including visa and passport validity rules.

Important Note

- The Meeting Visa cannot be extended.
- It cannot be converted into a Business Visa after arrival in the Maldives.
